An Ordinance authorizing the Mayor to enter into a one-year Agreement between the City of Birmingham and the Birmingham Emergency Communication District (“Birmingham 911”), pursuant to §11-98-4, Code of Alabama and Alabama Act 1969-916, to define the responsibilities of the City and Birmingham 911 related to replacement of old portable radios with new Motorola portable radios to be used by BPD and BFRS, including programming of the new portable radios. Birmingham 911 has the technical expertise to program the City’s new portable radios and intends to provide these services to the City, at no cost to the City, resulting in cost savings to the City of approximately \$300,000.00.
