A Resolution authorizing the Mayor, pursuant to §11-43-55 and §41-16-51(a)(15) of the Code of Alabama, to execute a First Amendment to the Installation & Monitoring Agreement with Vector Security, Inc., (a three-year Agreement beginning September 13, 2024, for security system monitoring at multiple facilities of the City). This Amendment adds additional equipment and services to be provided to the City by Vector Security, Inc at the BPD Headquarters Building and at the Arlington Historic House and Gardens, for the remaining 12 months of the Installation and Monitoring Agreement. The total “not to exceed amount” to be paid by the City under the Agreement shall be increased from Three Hundred Forty-three Thousand Seven Hundred Twenty-five and 84/100 dollars (\$343,725.84) to Three Hundred Seventy-eight Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty-Five and 84/100 dollars (\$378,855.84), beginning September 13, 2026.
